Violations of this policy would follow this chain of escalation:

Ask to cease the behaviour and / or leave the venue (this may be followed by a written warning)

Temporary suspension from attending Centaurs sports events

Being asked to leave the Club, which sadly affects the child member too, with no refund of fees

We hope to never implement such consequences within our community, but will not hesitate to do so for the protection of junior sport and the happiness, safety and wellbeing of our members.
